CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Take-home Scriptures and activities

Age 3-4

Acts 16: 16-34 Today we learned that we can worship God by praying to him. This week you might want to gather pictures of family members and friends that you would want to pray for together. Then make a prayer scrapbook with one page for each day of the week.

Pre-K and K

Acts 16:11-15 Today we learned that God calls us to share the good news about Jesus. Have each member of the family draw a picture or make a collage of the way that God is working in your lives.

Grades 1-2

Psalms 23 Today we learned that the psalms show us how to love God. Like music? Rewrite the words to "Jesus Loves Me". Start with something very simple such as 'I love Jesus, this I know....

Grades 3-4

Acts 16: 16-34 Today we learned that we can tell people about Jesus no matter where we are. Visit a food court where there are many different examples of foods eaten in other parts of the world. Sample the different types of food by sharing your meal with each other. OR, cook foods at home from different nationalities. Talk about

Grade 5

Philippians 1:20 Today we learned that real success in life is becoming like Jesus. Come up with ways that together as a family you can become more like Jesus. Choose specific characteristics of Jesus and then make a practical list of things you can do for each other and for others. Perhaps you can sign up for a mission project or VBS, or invite a friend to church.
